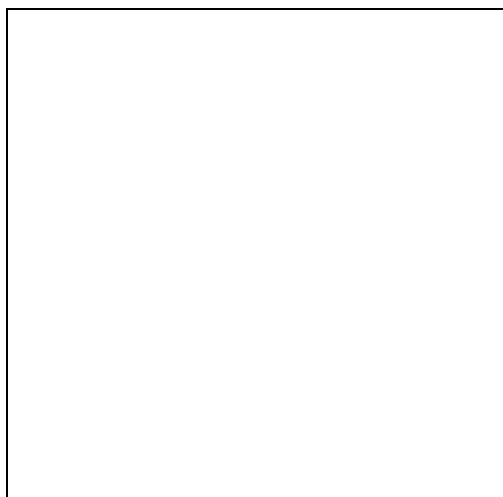

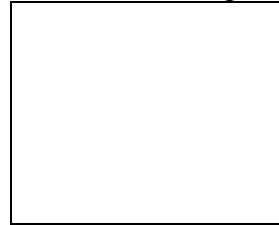
MEMBERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

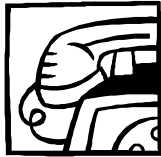
